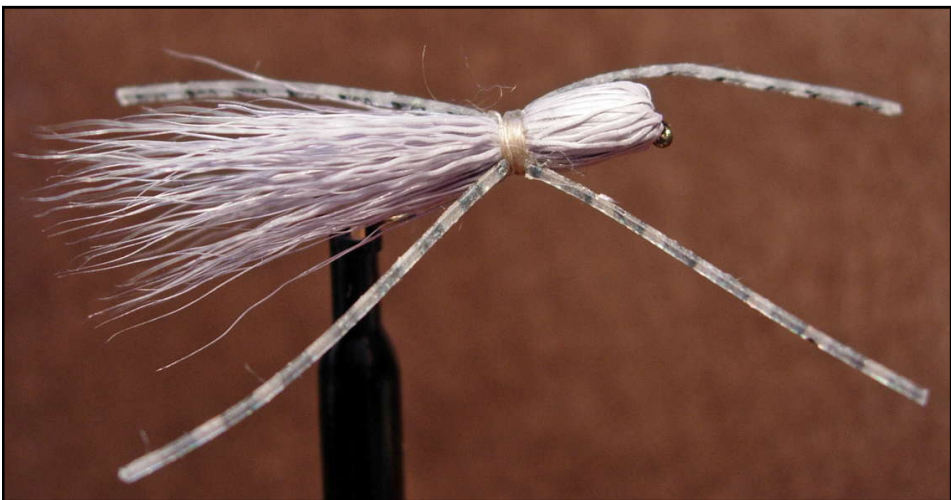

I have enjoyed putting out the UFTRI newsletter for several years.

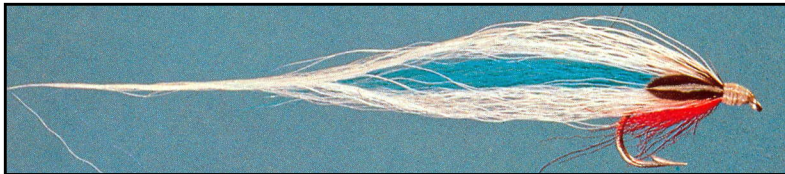
It has been rewarding to help organize the tying that our members enjoy doing, learning, and teaching.

The **Gibbs Striper** fly is an Intermediate Salt water tie that will be instructed by **John McCall**.

Recipe for Gibbs Striper Fly

Hook Eagle Claw 254 4 - 3/0
Thread White
Body Bills Body Braid
Wing White topped by Blue topped by White
Cheek Indian hen saddle feather

Recipe for Madame X:

Hook: 3xl dry fly. Mustad 94831
Thread: 3/0 yellow
Body, tail, and wing: Deer hair stacked
Legs: Yellow rubber
Hackle: Brown and grizzly mixed.

Dave Porreca will be tying a herring fly. The picture and the recipe were not available at “press time.”

The herring will be running soon. Early stripers in “the bay” in other estuaries will be chasing the herring. Dave will amplify on this and demonstrate his herring fly, a Saltwater tie.

Dick Pearce will be tying the Elk Hair Caddis and variants. This is a classic fresh water Beginner to Intermediate tie.



Elk Hair Caddis Recipe

Hook: Standard Dry fly size 10-18
Thread: Tan 6/0 or 8/0
Ribbing: Fine gold wire or thread.
Body: Tan, green, or gray dubbing.
Long CDC tied in at tip and palmered.
Hackle: Brown or Ginger palmered.
or long CDC tied in at tip and palmered.
Wing: Elk body or hock hair or costal deer hair or poly yarn.
